Requirements for progression of Range Officials

General requirements for participation as SAIRO Range Officials

Qualification Requirements

- 1. Must be at least 21 years
- 2. Must be affiliated to SAPSA
- 3. All practical evaluations will be set by SAIRO and conducted by a nominated Senior SAIRO Official with a pass mark of 75%
- 4. All written exams will be set by SAIRO and will have a pass mark of 75%
- 5. All applications to be directly submitted from applicant to SAIRO & I

<u>Trainee</u>

Qualification requirements

- 1. Must be approved by the club and provincial association
- 2. Fully completed registration form to be submitted to SAIRO

Range Officer/ Range Officer Assistance/ Stats officer

(under the auspices of the provincial association)

Qualification Requirements

- 1. Must have accumulated 16 level 2 or higher match points as a registered trainee within a period of three consecutive years
- 2. Must pass a written open book exam
- 3. Must pass a practical evaluation at a level 2 or higher match
- 4. Application must be endorsed and submitted to SAIRO by the provincial association

Minimum annual maintenance requirements

- 1. Must accumulate a minimum of 6 level 2 or higher points per year on a card system. The card will be renewed every year
- 2. Points card must be submitted to SAIRO before end January of the following year

Migration requirements

- 1. From ROA to RO the individual must pass two practical range officer evaluations at a level 2 or higher match over a period of 6 months
- 2. From ROA to Stats the individual must pass the written stats examination and one practical stats evaluation at a level 2 or higher match
- 3. From RO to Stats the individual must pass the written stats examination and one practical stats evaluation at a level 2 or higher match
- 4. From Stats to RO or ROA the individual must pass the written RO examination and one practical RO evaluation at a level 2 or higher match

Chief Range Officer / Chief Stats Officer

On notification from SAIRO of eligibility for possible promotion

Qualification Requirements

- 1. RO/SO to complete an application and submit directly to SAIRO
- 2. Must have accumulated 18 level 3 or higher match points as an RO/SO official accumulated within a period of 4 consecutive years
- 3. Points accumulation for promotion to CRO must include at least one match worked at a level 3 match as a crono official
- 4. Must have successfully completed a level one seminar
- 5. Must pass two practical evaluations as a level 3 or higher match
- 6. All applications will be circulated to current CRO/RM's and provincial associations for comments

For IROA sanction the CRO must accumulate points at at least one level 4 or 5 match Minimum annual maintenance requirements

- 1. Must accumulate a minimum of 6 level 2 or higher points per year on a card system. The card will be renewed every year
- 2. Must have at least 3 points on a level 3 or higher match in each two year cycle
- 3. Points card must be submitted to SAIRO before end January of the following year

Range Master

On notification from SAIRO of eligibility for possible promotion

Qualification Requirements

- 1. Must have accumulated 35 level 3 or higher match points as a CRO within a minimum period of 6 consecutive years including at least 2 level 4 or higher matches
- 2. Must have successfully preformed duty as a RM or ASS/RM at a minimum of two matches while accumulating these points
- 3. Application must be endorsed by at least two current RM's
- 4. Must pass two practical evaluation at a level 3 or higher match
- 5. Recommended the successful completion of a level 2 seminar
- 6. All applications will be circulated to current RM's and provincial associations for comment

Minimum annual maintenance requirements

- 1. Must accumulate a minimum of 6 level 2 or higher points per year on a card system. The card will be renewed every year
- 2. Must have at least 3 points on a level 3 or higher match in each two year cycle
- 3. Points card must be submitted to SAIRO before end January of the following year
